Narrative:

On Friday, November, 22nd at about 2327 hours I was assigned to Riverside Police Department's METRO/SWAT team. During this time, I heard Officer Hunt broadcast over the radio that shots had been fired. I responded to his location and assisted units already on scene.

A 'high risk' stop was in progress and Sgt. Cash asked that I assist in clearing the suspect vehicle. Once in place, a plan was developed to clear the vehicle using a police K-9 and two teams of officers: One team for the suspect vehicle and one team for two adjacent vehicles east of the primary vehicle. It was unknown at that time if the vehicle were involved in any way.

After the K-9 was deployed, Officer Larkin, Officer Barnhill and I cleared the suspect vehicle. On our approach to the vehicle I saw a Hispanic male adult partially inside the vehicle with his face down. The subject's legs were outside of the vehicle. While Officer Barnhill placed him into handcuffs, Officer Larkin and I cleared the vehicle of any other occupants.

I remained at the scene and assisted with scene security.

While at the location, we identified several witnesses at 3055 East La Cadena. I spoke to W [REDACTED] She said she was in the front yard of the residence and heard someone say there was a police car out front. She went to see then immediately saw a male subject begin shooting at the police car. [REDACTED] said she heard about 3 gun shots. She said she then saw the Officer take cover behind his police car. [REDACTED] said she did not see the police officer shoot at all.

[REDACTED] described the shooter as a male wearing a gray sweater and possibly a hat. After the shots, [REDACTED] ran inside the house. [REDACTED]'s statement was recorded in detail using my department issued digital recorder.

From previous contacts and arrest, I know that the house across the street from where the shooting occurred was a problem drug house: 3071 East La Cadena. I advised Sgt. Cash of the location. Using law enforcement data bases, I ran criminal history on the house and located two probations residing at the location. Both documented gang members:

Galvan, Gerald
[REDACTED] (probation case RIF1301103)

Galvan, Paula
[REDACTED] (probation case RIF1302432)

Paula was found to have two outstanding felony warrants for her arrest. Also, under the driveway awning of the residence was an exterior camera that was pointing out to the street where the shooting occurred.

1 Several hours later, Detective Medici, Officer Jones, Officer Mowery, Officer Weddle and I conducted a
2 probation compliance check of the residence in attempts to locate any evidence, witnesses, and locate
3 Paula who was wanted. We knocked at the location and a male adult came to the door (see Detective
4 Medici's report for details). We cleared the residence and located Gerald Galvan; however, Paula was not
5 there. In one of the rear bedrooms I located the monitor attached to the exterior camera. The camera did
6 cover the street where the shooting occurred, however, was not recording.

8 Detective Medici identified all the occupants of the residence and we left the location.

10 I was later relived from the scene by Sgt. Cash at about 0330 hours.
