1 **Narrative:**

2 On Friday, November 22, 2013, at approximately 2327 hours, I responded "code 3" from
3 the Orange Street Police station to assist "A137" after he broadcast that he was out with a
4 couple subjects with "shots fired" at First and Vine Streets. While in route, "A137" advised he
5 was shot at, he was okay, but unknown if the suspect was outstanding. Upon arrival, I saw a
6 light, possibly tan or gold colored, older Nissan Altima parked facing north on the east side of La
7 Cadena, south of Poma Fuels. I saw a patrol car parked facing south about 30 feet west of the
8 Altima on La Cadena. Parked alongside it facing north, was another patrol car. I saw two
9 officers crouched down with long guns drawn, pointed in the direction of the Altima. I took a
10 position directly next to Officer Hunt ("A137") and Officer Zuetel. I could see the driver window
11 of the Altima had a hole through it. I could not see into the vehicle either because the window
12 was fogged over, or the window was broken, but still intact in the frame.

13 Officer Hunt told me he was confident a subject was still in the driver seat, and that shots
14 came from the area of the passenger side. Officer Hunt told me he returned fire, but was
15 unsure if the shooter was still on scene. I focused my attention on the vehicle and the area east
16 of the car.

17 We changed positions from the passenger side toward the front of Officer Hunt's vehicle
18 to a more advantageous position behind the second patrol vehicle. I maintained constant visual
19 of the suspect vehicle. Air 1 was flying overhead and reported seeing a subject laying on the
20 passenger side of the vehicle.

21 A plan was formed and executed by officers south of the suspect vehicle. Two subjects
22 were removed from the Altima and detained. A third subject was located on the passenger side
23 of the vehicle, unresponsive.

24 I located two shell casings at the scene within very close proximity of Officer Hunt's patrol
25 car. I placed plastic yellow "1" placard next to the casing closest to the suspect vehicle, and a
26 "2" placard next to the casing under the trunk area of the second patrol car. I also marked
27 black, hard plastic pieces lying directly under the driver side mirror that was similar to the
28 missing black plastic from Officer Hunt's side mirror with placard "3". I saw two bullet strike
29 marks on the driver side directly forward of Officer Hunt's door and placed placard "4" on the
30 hood near the damage.

31 I searched the female detainee for weapons or illegal items prior to her being transported
32 to the Magnolia station for further investigation.
