Narrative:

On 11-22-13 at approximately 2327 hours, I was on routine patrol when I heard Ofc. Hunt advise Dispatch over the radio that he was at First St. and Vine St., and shots had been fired. Believing Ofc. Hunt was possibly involved in a shooting, I immediately activated my emergency lights and siren and began responding to that area. I arrived at approximately 2328 hours. As I arrived on scene, I was traveling east bound on First St., then made a north bound turn onto E. La Cadena Drive. When I turned onto E. La Cadena Dr., I saw Ofc. Hunt's vehicle (Unit #3934) facing south on E. La Cadena Drive. Ofc. Hunt was kneeling down behind the front passenger portion of his patrol vehicle. (It was apparent to me that Ofc. Hunt was using the vehicle as concealment.) At that time, Ofc. Hunt was facing east bound toward the driver side of a gold colored Nissan sedan (CA/7CHH175). I exited my vehicle and ran to Ofc. Hunt's location. Ofc. Hunt informed me that he last saw the suspect from the shooting on the passenger side of the aforementioned Nissan (CA/7CHH175), and was unsure of the suspect's whereabouts at that moment. Assisting officers responded along with Air 1, and a perimeter was established for possible outstanding suspect(s).

At one point, assisting officers advised that there was a subject on the passenger side of the vehicle, with the upper portion of his body inside the vehicle. Also, officers were able to see a subject in the front driver seat of the vehicle. A plan was formulated and a felony stop on the vehicle was conducted. Two subjects ultimately exited the vehicle and were taken into custody. While assisting officers contacted the suspect on the passenger side of the vehicle, I was tasked to aid in scene security by checking and clearing other nearby vehicles further east of the Nissan. The scene was eventually rendered safe and I was assigned to a perimeter position for scene security. I was relieved from my perimeter position by Sgt. Wood at approximately 0500 hours.
