## Details:

On 11-23-13 at approximately 0116 hours I responded to 3020 E. La Cadena Drive in Riverside to assist with an Officer Involved Shooting Investigation. Upon my arrival I observed (2) separate businesses with surveillance cameras visible on the buildings.

On 11-23-12, I made contact with Bob Biber from Eagle Road Service while I was on scene. Biber took Detective Rick Wheeler and I to the DVR equipment that recorded the incident in question. I watched the recording while on scene and I noted the cameras captured a distorted and distant view of the incident. I was able to identify Officer Hunt's patrol car as it arrived on scene. I was able to see Officer Hunt shine a spotlight on the suspect's vehicle. I then noted a brief flash of light and movement of at least one silhouette walking or running back in the direction of Officer Hunt's patrol car. Detective Wheeler recorded a copy of the surveillance video on a flash drive to retain as evidence and view again at a later time.

I made several unsuccessful attempts to contact someone from Poma Fueling on the night of the incident. During the days that followed I was eventually able to make contact with James Tebeau (Director) of Poma. On 12-10-13 at approximately 0945 hours I met with Tebeau at his office in the city of Bloomington. He provided me with a flash drive recording of the incident. I went back to the Magnolia Station and I viewed the recording. The images recorded were very poor quality and the cameras recorded the incident from what appeared to be a long distance away from where the shooting occurred. It was extremely difficult to see anything other than an initial spotlight from Officer Hunt's patrol car followed by several other lights from responding patrol units.

I copied the flash drive onto a DVD and gave it to Detective Dave Smith for his casebook. I booked the flash drive into evidence.

# P.A.C.T. Search at 3071 La Cadena:

During the initial scene investigation I noted there were video camera's attached to the exterior of a residence located at 3071 La Cadena Avenue. While assisting personnel and I were conducting the initial investigation, I observed unknown residents inside of that location were periodically peering out of the window at us. The interior lights of the residence suspiciously went off and on intermittently. I was advised by first responding patrol officers that when they

conducted an initial canvass for witnesses the residents at 3071 La Cadena refused to answer the door. Officer Silvio Macias of P.A.C.T. was familiar with the residence. Officer Macias advised that he's personally made several contacts and arrests related to the location for narcotics and criminal activity. He told me that the primary resident identified as Gerald Galvan is currently on probation and has active search terms for the residence. With P.A.C.T's assistance we made contact with the residents inside. We asked several residents to exit onto the front porch. P.A.C.T. did a safety sweep inside and found Mr. Galvan hiding in the kitchen. I went inside the house to look for evidence of video recordings from the exterior cameras. I saw a video monitor in one of the rear bedrooms. It was on and displaying the activity currently going on outside on the street. The cameras were used for viewing only. The system had no DVR or any other recording capabilities. The occupants of the residence all claimed to have not seen or heard anything related to the shooting that occurred outside. No other actions were
