10 **Evidence:**

11 Inside this vehicle, ID Tech McKay-Davis and I located several items of evidence. They
12 included a baseball cap, a CDL (for Christian Mendoza [REDACTED]), a long awl, a Master Card
13 (located in a woman's purse) and .3 grams (with packaging) of a brown tar like substance test
14 and believed to be Heroin. The items were collected by ID Tech McKay-Davis and booked into
15 property. See her supplemental report for details.

17 **Investigation:**

18 On the morning of November 26, 2013, Supv. ID Tech Fuller, ID Tech McKay-Davis, Det. Smith
19 and I conducted a search of the vehicle involved in an officer involved shooting investigation
20 from November 22, 2013. Det. Smith had obtained permission to search the vehicle from the
21 owner during his investigation.

23 ID Tech McKay-Davis began the search by photographing the interior and exterior of the
24 vehicle. We then conducted the search and located the listed items. Those items were marked
25 and photographed before collection. The items were located in the following locations; black
26 baseball cap (in the back passenger floor board area), CDL (in the front passenger door
27 pocket), .3 grams of Heroin (under the front passenger seat and in the torn corner of a small
28 white baggie), long awl (back passenger seat). Master card (inside of a woman's purse on the
29 back seat)

31 Supv. ID Tech Fuller looked at the gunshot holes in the vehicle and gave his opinion on
32 direction of travel. Based on how the windows had cracked and the lack of glass on the exit
33 side of the glass, he determined that all of the shots in the windows traveled from the driver's
34 side to the passenger side. The ricochet on top of the car appeared to him as being from the
35 passenger side toward the driver's side based on the form of the dent made by the bullet.

37 **Disposition:**

38 Once the items were collected, Det. Smith released the vehicle to the registered owner. This
39 report will be forwarded to Det. Smith for his casebook.
