**Narrative:**

On 11-23-13, at approximately 0130 hours, I was contacted at home by Sergeant D. Russell and asked to assist with an Officer Involved Shooting investigation, which occurred on 11-22-13 at approximately 2327 hours. The shooting occurred at 3020 E. La Cadena Drive in the city and county of Riverside but I was asked to respond directly to the Riverside Police Department, Magnolia Station to assist.

While at the Magnolia Station, Case Agent Detective D. Smith asked that I assist Senior Forensic Technician L. Velin with photographs, Gunshot Residue and DNA collection from Jose Estrada and Stephanie Suarez.

At 0320 hours, Senior Forensic Technician Velin began by taking photographs of Jose Estrada, who was in interview room #2. She then conducted a Gunshot Residue (GSR) collection kit from both of Estrada's hands.

At 0332 hours, Senior Forensic Technician Velin took photographs of Stephanie Suarez, who was in interview room #1. She then conducted a Gunshot Residue (GSR) collection kit from both of Suarez's hands.

Upon completion of the above request we were asked to chart Officer Hunt's weapons. At approximately 0350 hours, we met with Officer Hunt and his attorney in the Forensic Unit area of the Magnolia Station for the purpose of charting his firearms. Officer Hunt had deployed his patrol rifle during this incident so he brought it with him to the station for charting. Officer Hunt retrieved his Patrol Rifle from a police vehicle at the Magnolia Station for charting.

**Officer S. Hunt (#1680)**

Senior Forensic Technician L. Velin started by taking photographs of Officer Hunt. Officer Hunt had no injuries from the incident and no damage to his clothing or gear. Officer Hunt was wearing a full Riverside Police Department long sleeve uniform. Officer Hunt had his badge on the left chest, name tag over the right shirt pocket and department patches on both sleeves. He was wearing a leather Sam Browne duty belt.

**Duty Weapon**

Glock .40 caliber (semi-auto) Model 22 Serial# FFY982

The weapon had one (1) round in the chamber and thirteen (13) additional rounds in the magazine, which has a fifteen (15) round maximum capacity. The weapon also has a Streamlight TLRS flashlight attached.

The two (2) additional magazines from the magazine pouch were also fifteen (15) round capacity and were both loaded to capacity.

**Patrol Rifle**

Colt .556mm Model 6940 Serial# LE092845

The weapon had one (1) round in the chamber and twenty-nine (29) additional rounds in the magazine, which has a thirty (30) round capacity. The rifle also had a Streamlight TLRS flashlight attached to it.

**Back-Up Weapon**

Glock .40 caliber (semi-auto) Model 27 Serial# TAE992

Officer Hunt carries the above back-up weapon on his right ankle. The weapon had one (1) round in the chamber and ten (10) rounds in the magazine.

Based on the charting of Officer Hunt's weapons, he fired two (2) rounds from his duty weapon, and did not fire any rounds from his patrol rifle or back up weapon.

We collected Officer Hunt's duty weapon (SH001) but he kept possession of his back-up weapon and patrol rifle.

Officer Hunt was given a Glock, Model 22, Serial #FFY809, as a replacement weapon until his weapon has been processed and can be released.
