62. Narrative of Supplemental Report

I am a sworn peace officer with the rank of Sergeant, employed by the Riverside Police Department, and assigned to patrol division.

On the morning of 11-16-11, at approximately 0730, I heard a call of 11-99 (Officer in distress/ mayday) over the radio. I responded from Lincoln Station to the location of the incident, 10406 Indiana Ave.

The suspect's apartment is a ground-level corner apartment on the southeast corner of an apartment building located within the south western area of the apartment complex. The main door of the apartment faces north onto a common breezeway, and was standing ajar upon our arrival. The apartment has a small covered patio on the east side, accessible from inside the apartment via a sliding glass door. We were told that the male occupant of the apartment had engaged detectives with a shotgun during their service of a search warrant at the apartment and that they returned fire. It was not certain whether the suspect was injured. Medical aid was called to the scene and staged near the entrance to the apartment complex.

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I initially took a perimeter position within the apartment complex, covering the suspect's apartment with my rifle. I then moved up to the point position to supervise the officers on point. Officers had evacuated the residents of the next-door apartment, and Officers Glover and Watkins took a position inside the neighboring apartment, covering the open door of the suspect's apartment across the breezeway. Officers N. Asbury, P. Cisneros, and G. Lucero, along with Detectives Jones and Simons were also present and assisting in covering the front of the apartment.

I had Det. Jones make contact with the residents of the two adjoining apartments to the rear of the suspect's apartment. He evacuated the residents of one and received no answer at the other.

I called for 40mm Less Lethal and an arrest team. Ofc. Hill arrived with Trainee Ofc. Cruz. I designated them as the arrest team. Ofc. Ortiz arrived with a 40mm Less Lethal.

Ofc. Glover was able to engage the suspect in conversation and made several attempts to get him to surrender himself. The suspect claimed to have a gunshot wound to his leg, but either could not or would not crawl to the front door to surrender himself. Myself and the other mentioned officers remained in place until officers from the Metro Team arrived to relieve us. I gave report to Sgt. Whitt, who assumed control of the point position. At that time, Officers Glover, Watkins, Hill, Ortiz, and Cruz remained to help maintain a perimeter and assist the Metro Officers. Myself and the other mentioned officers checked in at the command post and left the scene.

At no time did I personally observe or have any direct contact with the suspect.
