Details:

On 11-16-11, at approximately 0800 hours, I was on my way to METRO training in a department issued marked black and white police unit. I heard on the radio that officers were involved in a shooting and requested an 11-99. I responded to the scene and formed up with other METRO officers on scene. We formed an arrest team and positioned ourselves in an apartment directly across a small breezeway from the suspect apartment. We were in Apt. 243 while the suspect was in Apt. 242.

The team set up at the doorway of Apt. 243. I attempted to make verbal contact with the suspect inside Apt. 242. The door to Apt. 242 was standing partially open and I could see into the apartment. For approximately 10 minutes I attempted verbal contact with no response. I could not see anyone moving or hear any noises inside the apartment.

After the deployment of a small "recon robot" with a camera and a larger TSU robot, we were able to see someone lying in the hallway of the apartment. The subject was not moving and did not respond to commands by me or through the speaker on the robot.

The arrest team made entry into the apartment through the front door. the team cleared the apartment and rendered it safe. The male suspect in the hallway of the apartment was unresponsive and medical aid was called into the apartment to render aid. AMR personnel pronounced the subject deceased and all METRO personnel exited the apartment. The scene was turned over to Robbery/homicide Detectives on scene.
