1 **Assignment:**

2 On November 16, 2011 at around 0717 hrs, I was driving in my unmarked RPD detective unit in the
3 area of Van Buren & Victoria, Riverside. While at this intersection, I heard an 11-99 shots fired/ call for
4 assistance go out from detectives attempting to serve a search warrant at the Tyler Springs Apts (10406
5 Indiana Ave. #Q242 Riverside, CA). I drove to this location and found several marked RPD units
6 already on scene. Hearing that uniformed officers were already assisting the detectives at apartment
7 #Q242, I went to the main office of the apartment complex and began to gather information on the
8 people who lived in that apartment. After gathering this info and giving it to the officers running the
9 command post, I met with member of the Robbery/Homicide Unit to be given further assignment. I was
10 asked to speak with the two upstairs tenants, located directly above and above to the north of the
11 primary apartment.

13 **W/Wortness Atkins:**

14 Wortness was inside her apartment, with her daughter W/Joyce Atkins, at the time of this incident.
15 Wortness had been asleep and woke up around 0730 hrs when she heard some loud banging come from
16 outside of her apartment. She was not sure from where the banging originated. She heard 5-6 bangs and
17 then things were quiet until police officers started to arrive down stairs. She had no further details about
18 this incident.

20 Wortness did not know the people who lived in the apartment below her (#Q242). She had only casual
21 contact with the man and woman and it was always pleasant.

23 **W/Joyce Atkins:**

24 Joyce was staying with her mother when this incident happened. She too was asleep when she was
25 awakened by a loud bang coming from outside. Joyce got up and went to investigate the noise. As she
26 got out of bed, around five minutes later, she heard approximately 15 possible gunshots come from
27 downstairs. Joyce looked outside from her mother's balcony and saw some people dressed in civilian
28 clothes near the downstairs apartment. Seeing these people, she went back into the apartment and stayed
29 there. She had nothing more to add to today's case.

31 **W/Pearlene Baker:**

32 Pearlene was asleep in her apartment when she was awakened by her phone ringing. When she
33 answered it, a person identifying themselves as a RPD sergeant, told her to go to the back of her
34 apartment and wait for officers to contact her. Pearlene followed his directions and went to a safe place
35 in her apartment. She did not hear any noises that morning before the phone call.

37 Pearlene did not have much contact with the people in #Q242. She would say hi and have small talk
38 with the husband and wife who lived there. She commented they seemed nice. She last had a casual
39 conversation with the wife on Friday (November 11th).
