Notification:

On Sunday 10-14-12 at approximately 2320 hours, Sergeant Dave Amador contacted me at home and advised me that an officer involved shooting just occurred. At his request I responded to the scene at 3750 Myers Street to assist with the investigation. I arrived at approximately 0010 hours and I met with assisting detectives from the Robbery/Homicide Unit. We were briefed by Patrol Sergeant K. Lambert who provided us with details surrounding the incident. After the briefing, I was assigned to handle the crime scene investigation with assistance from ID Supervisor C. Fuller and ID Technician Sue Lane. Detective Rick Cobb was assigned as the case agent in charge of the overall investigation.

Crime Scene Description:

The location of occurrence at 3750 Myers is an apartment complex located in a primarily residential neighborhood with homes on both sides of Myers Street. The crime scene itself was the upstairs landing directly outside the front door to apartment #55.

Upon my arrival, I noted yellow crime scene tape was already being utilized by Patrol Officers to block off all pedestrian access to the second story landing of apartment #55 and its neighboring apartments. I noted the body of a deceased male who was later identified as S/Sherron was lying on the landing immediately outside of apartment marked #55. Uniformed Patrol Officers were guarding the body and several evidence items on the landing. A secondary crime scene was established in the open courtyard and grass area immediately below apartment #55. The courtyard was protected by yellow crime scene tape. Uniformed personnel were posted in the courtyard to protect evidence items including a replica semi-automatic handgun, spent casings, and other ballistic evidence.

Description of S/Sherron:

Sherron was lying on his Stomach on the landing immediately outside of the apartment marked as #55. His head was facing southeast and his feet were facing northwest. Sherron's hands were handcuffed behind his back by the involved officers at the time of the incident. He was fully clothed in a black T-shirt, plaid shorts, and black shoes.

Processing of the Crime Scene & Evidence Collected:

ID Technician S. Lane began processing the crime scene by taking video and digital photographs of the entire scene. We identified and collected (11) expended .40 caliber shell casings on both the landing and in the courtyard below. We identified (9) possible strike marks throughout the scene. I noted (2) possible strike marks in the floor of the landing by Sherron's body. I noted additional strike marks in the railing, ceiling, and stucco walls on the landing and (1) final strike mark to an adjacent apartment building on the other side of the pool area north of the actual crime scene. Refer to the crime scene sketches by Carlton Fuller and Sue Lane for all measurements and the exact locations of the strike marks.

Processing Bond's Body on Scene:

After marking and collecting all of the identified evidence, Deputy Coroner Escobar responded and examined Sherron's body on scene. Deputy Escobar checked for external injuries by lifting Sherron's shirt and exposing (3) possible GSW's to the left side of his body. I noted there was (1) possible GSW to the area of his left rib cage, (1) GSW to his left chest, and (1) final GSW to the area of his collar bone or lower neck on his left side. No other external trauma was noted.

The coroner's office took custody of Sherron's body and they transported him to the Riverside County Coroner's Office. Deputy Escobar completed a GSR kit on both of Sherron's hands before transporting him. Then Deputy Escobar bagged both hands for evidence preservation. We concluded and cleared the crime scene at approximately 0700 hours.
