

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

The City of Riverside Human Relations Commission is seeking nominations of deserving volunteers to be honored as “Riverside Heroes.”

CRITERIA:

- Nominee must reside within the city limits of Riverside.
- Nominee’s volunteer activities must have been performed in the City of Riverside and within the past year.
- The service, achievements or accomplishments on which the nomination is based must have been performed on a volunteer basis, without pay.
- Nominee’s volunteer activities must have provided a benefit to the community in a substantial, important or unique way.
- Nominations will be open for volunteers of all ages. Ineligible are self-nominations, elected officials, groups or organizations.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The Heroes Awards Committee will evaluate the nominations ensuring criteria for nomination is met. Selection is based upon the nominee’s volunteer efforts, accomplishments and impact. The nomination should reflect a meaningful commitment of time and service by the nominee. The nominee’s service should address a community need and/or enhance the quality of life for Riversiders and demonstrate acts of generosity and kindness.

HEROES CEREMONY:

Award recipients will be honored by the City of Riverside Human Relations Commission at a ceremony scheduled for 6 p.m. on December 6, 2012, at the Grier Pavilion, 3900 Main St., 7th Floor, Riverside.


