#### **CELEBRATING CULTURES: SPAIN** Mission Inn Museum

Join the Mission Inn Museum as we celebrate cultures that influenced the beautiful art and architecture of the Mission Inn. This month we will be creating Spanish castanets, a hand-held musical instrument that is often used in traditional Spanish dances. Our castanets will feature metal bottle caps that make wonderful percussion sounds for dancing! Frank Miller, the founder of the Mission Inn, traveled to Spain in 1911, and most of the Mission Inn's architecture is influenced by Spanish styles. The beautiful Spanish patio inside the Mission Inn features arched walls, decorative tiles, fountains, and statues that were inspired by Spanish architecture.
