Sample Container

It's unlawful to put medical sharps such as hypodermic needles, lancets, pen needles etc. into curbside collection recycle or trash containers.

Sharps must be inside a sealed container, such as a sharps disposal container or a hard-sided PLASTIC container such as a bleach or laundry detergent bottle with a secure lid. Containers must have a label that states "Biohazard". For more information and downloadable labels visit: riversideca.gov/publicworks/trash/HHW-sharps.asp
