Suspect Arrested for Possession of Four Stolen Gaming Tables

Riverside, CA -- On Wednesday, May 26, 2010, Riverside Police arrested one suspect in connection to a burglary that occurred in the 2500 block of Kansas Avenue in the City of Riverside.

Detectives from the North-NPC Investigations Unit located three stolen 8-in-1 gaming tables at a residence in the City of Highland. During the investigation, detectives located a fourth gaming table in the unincorporated area of Riverside County known as Winchester. The 8-in-1 gaming tables are very unique by design and only sold by one individual in the United States. The gaming tables are a dark honey wood finish with carved leaf design on the eight sided edge of the top section. The tables are supported by a four-pedestal claw foot base. The four gaming tables are valued at approximately \$7,200.00.

Approximately \$50, 000 in gaming tables such as foosball tables, Texas hold'em tables, pool table components and 100 matching chairs designed for the gaming tables were taken during two separate burglaries.
