Bank Robbery Suspect Arrested

Riverside, CA – On Thursday June 10, 2010 officers from the Port Aransas Police Department, and members of the Inland Regional Apprehension Team, arrested 22 year old **Zachary Clark** of Riverside in Port Aransas, Texas.

Zachary Clark is believed to be responsible for six separate bank robberies within the City of Riverside. The first robbery occurred on March 29, 2010 and the most recent robbery occurred on May 29. In each incident Clark passed a note to the bank teller demanding cash. After receiving the cash, Clark fled from the locations.

Detectives from the Riverside Police Department were able to identify Clark after the May 29 robbery and were following up on leads throughout Southern California and surrounding states. Believing that Clark was no longer in Riverside, we requested the assistance of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, utilizing the Inland Regional Apprehension Team.

Zachary Clark is scheduled for extradition back to Riverside within the next few weeks. Upon his return to Riverside, Clark will be charged with six (6) counts of robbery and one (1) count of attempt robbery.
