Two Bicyclists Collide with Vehicle

Riverside, CA -- On 12/11/10, at 0918 hours, Officers of the Riverside Police Department responded to the intersection of Washington St and Victoria Ave. reference a traffic collision. Officers arrived on scene and found two cyclists and a motor vehicle had collided in the intersection. The officers were able to locate independent witnesses to the collision and obtained their statements.

The two cyclists, both 38 Y/O males, were Eastbound on Victoria Ave. approaching the stop sign controlled intersection of Victoria Ave. and Washington St. when they entered into the intersection without stopping for the clearly visible stop sign and limit line on Victoria Ave. They collided with a motorist, a 37 Y/O female, traveling Northbound on Washington St., who also failed to stop for the clearly visible stop sign and limit line on Washington St. A Witness following the cyclists told officers that neither cyclist made any attempt to stop or slow down prior to entering the intersection.

The cyclists were transported to Riverside Community Hospital for treatment of minor injuries.
