Riverside Police Handle Barricaded Suspect

SWAT resolves a five hour standoff

Riverside, CA -- On Tuesday January 12, 2010, around 1 am, Officers responded to the 8900 block of Indiana Ave in the City of Riverside answering a phone call reporting a man making threats to kill the reporting party and her children. The reporting person said that the man usually was armed with a gun but no gun was seen during this incident.

Officers responded and spoke with the reporting party who directed them to the attic. She said that the man is her ex-boyfriend and was currently hiding in the attic. The officers requested additional units and supervision. They tried to vain to persuade the man to come down and surrender.

After trying for nearly 2 hours, patrol supervision requested the SWAT team. The specially trained officers responded with their team, including Hostage Negotiators and took over the incident.

The man was finally persuaded to surrender a little before 5:30 am. He was taken into custody without injury and was transported to the Riverside County Jail for booking.

He is identified as:

Daniel Calderon, 24 years old, a resident of Riverside.

No weapon was found on his person or in the residence. A search of his vehicle found narcotics, money and brass knuckles.

He was booked for:

422 PC – Terrorist Threats.
148 PC – Delaying or Resisting a Police Officer.
11379 HS – Possession of narcotics for sale.
