Riverside Police DUI Checkpoint Nets 3 DUI Arrests

The Riverside Police Department conducted a DUI/Driver's License Checkpoint on Friday, September 2, 2011, as part of Riverside's commitment to public safety. This checkpoint was one of many that have been or will be conducted throughout the year in the City of Riverside. The location of Friday's checkpoint was on Magnolia Avenue at Banbury Drive. The goal of the DUI Checkpoint was removing unlicensed or impaired drivers and to bring awareness to the public of the dangers of driving under the influence of drugs and alcohol.

In addition to enforcing traffic laws the Department's personnel assisted twenty-two families with the proper installation of their child safety seats to ensure the safety of the little ones passing through the checkpoint.

Results:

- 2576 vehicles passed through the checkpoint.
- 2576 drivers were screened.
- 3 DUI suspects were arrested.
- 107 citations were issued.
- 43 vehicles were impounded.
- 53 unlicensed and suspended drivers were sent to court.

The checkpoint was funded by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. Report Drunk Drivers – Call 9-1-1!
