Police Seek Public's Help In Missing Adult Case

Riverside, CA – On Sunday, September 23, 2012, officers from the Riverside Police Department responded to a residence in the 4300 block of Hillside Street reference a report of a missing female adult. A mother was reporting her adult daughter as a missing person and advised she had not had contact with her daughter for approximately two weeks. It has now been almost 4 weeks since anybody has had contact with Ms. Dow.

The missing female is identified as Kimberly Lynn DOW, she is 30 years old, and a resident of Riverside. Ms. Dow is described as a white female, 5'-6", 150 pounds with brown hair, and brown eyes. (see page 2 photograph) Ms. Dow was last seen and or heard from on September 9, 2012. Ms. Dow suffers from a medical condition that requires medication to treat. It is unknown if Ms. Dow has any medication with her.

Up until her disappearance, Ms. Dow had been living with her boyfriend, **Thomas James Fulk**, 35, of Riverside (see page 2 photograph), at Fulk's father's residence in the 2800 block of Irving in the City of Riverside. Detectives have been attempting to contact Mr. Fulk for questioning in regard to Ms. Dow's disappearance. Detectives believe Mr. Fulk has been actively avoiding contact by law enforcement. The Riverside Superior Court issued an arrest warrant for Mr. Fulk for violation of probation on two unrelated cases for failure to report to the Riverside County Probation Department. These warrants were issued on October 5, 2010.

Detectives from the Robbery / Homicide Unit are involved in the investigation and through the investigation believe the victim's disappearance is suspicious in nature and believe Ms. Dow is the victim of foul play.


