Riverside, California — The Riverside Police Department has many exciting volunteer opportunities to engage and involve our community members. This recruitment period will run through Friday, April 26th, 2013. We are recruiting volunteers for the following positions.

Mall Walkers: Citizen Volunteers are needed to patrol in our local malls as extra eyes and ears. Volunteers are trained to identify what is suspicious and to report the information to the mall security. Must be able to walk or move about the mall for the duration of a two hour shift. There are 16 positions available.

Crime Free Multi Housing: Citizen Volunteers perform annual property inspections and assist in developing lasting partnerships with the local apartment property managers. Must be available to work both day and evening hours. There are 5 positions available.

You Are Not Alone: Citizen Volunteers make calls to program participants to provide encouragement and companionship. There are 5 positions available.
