Armed Robbery Suspects Apprehended

Riverside, CA – On, Monday, November 5th, 2007, at approximately 0226 hours, Riverside Police officers responded to 5720 Sycamore Canyon Blvd. reference an armed robbery that just occurred at the Box Springs Station (convenience store).

A male subject, later identified as Donovan Stubbs (age 19), entered the store wearing a bandana over his face and carrying a rifle. The suspect confronted the store clerk demanding money from the cash register. The suspect fled the store in an unknown direction with the cash from the register. The store clerk who was not injured during the incident called police to report the robbery.

While police officers were en route to the Box Springs Station, an officer observed a vehicle pull into the parking lot of a gas station at Blaine Street and Iowa Avenue in the city of Riverside. While observing the vehicle, the officer observed a male subject that matched the description of the robbery suspect from the Box Springs Station. The suspect and two other adult male subjects fled the parking lot on foot when they saw the police officer. A short time later, officers who were still in the area looking for the suspects located one of the three subjects and detained him. He is identified as Leonard McCoy (age 21 of Fontana). A second subject later identified as Terrence Scott (age 18 of Fontana) was located and detained. Officers located a rifle and other items inside the vehicle that was left behind by the three subjects.

On Tuesday, November 6th, 2007, Riverside Police Department's Metro Team located the third subject at his residence in Fontana. Donovan Stubbs was taken into custody. All three suspects were booked into Robert Presley Detention Center for armed robbery and conspiracy to commit robbery.
