### **Police Arrest Robbery Suspects**

Riverside, CA -- On January 22, 2009, at approximately 2349 hours, Riverside Police Department officers responded to a call of a robbery at Barton Road, north of Van Buren, Riverside. A male victim reported that he was walking on Barton Road and was approached by a vehicle with three occupants. The victim was robbed at gunpoint of his personal belongings. The suspects fled the scene in a black Chevrolet truck. Approximately 40 minutes later, as police were still investigating the robbery incident, dispatch received a call from a reporting party of a solo hit-and-run accident in the 8900 block of Douglas Fir. The vehicle description provided by the reporting party was similar to the vehicle reported in the robbery incident.

The Riverside Police Department's Air One helicopter was flying in the area and spotted the suspect vehicle in the 19900 block of Silver Crest lane, Riverside. Officers responded to the scene and set up a perimeter. Due to the nature of the robbery incident involving a gun, the Riverside Police Department SWAT team responded and assumed tactical operations of the scene.

After several hours of unsuccessful phone calls into the residence, the suspects surrendered peacefully to police.

An adult suspect and a juvenile suspect are in custody at this time. Aaron Terrall Lee, 18 years, from Riverside was booked into County Jail for robbery charges. The male juvenile was booked into Juvenile Hall on robbery charges. A third suspect is outstanding at this time.
