Victim Of Robbery Recovering From Gun Shot Wound

Riverside, CA – On Thursday June 4, 2009 at 10:03 a.m. officers from the Riverside Police Department responded to the 12100 block of Severn Way, after receiving reports of a gunshot victim in the area.

Upon the officers' arrival an adult male was located suffering from a gunshot wound to the head. The victim was transported to Riverside Community Hospital where the wound was determined to be non-life threatening. The victim's identity is not being released.

Based on information received from the victim and witnesses, the victim was inside of his business when two unknown males entered the business and demanded cash. The victim provided the suspects with an undisclosed amount of cash, and prior to fleeing the business one of the suspects fired a handgun striking the victim once.

Homicide Investigators responded and were assisted in their investigation by personnel from the Forensic Unit. The investigation is ongoing and there is no additional information available at this time.
