Arlington Avenue Sexual Assault Suspect Arrest

Riverside, CA -- On Friday morning, March 13, 2009 about 7:45 AM, Riverside Police Detectives located a suspect they believe to be responsible for a series of sexual assaults that occurred in the 4600 block of Arlington Avenue.

Detectives have been investigating two separate incidents that occurred at an assisted living home, one attack that occurred on the street, and another attack that occurred in an apartment complex. The first occurrence was reported in December 2008 which at the time detectives believed to be an isolated incident. The second and third reports were made at the beginning and end of February 2009 which led investigators to believe it involved the same suspect. The last attack occurred during the first week of March 2009 and was the most significant of all the incidents. Evidence was recovered which positively linked this suspect to the crime.

Terrell Dante Adams, (26) of Riverside was arrested and booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center in downtown Riverside for Sexual Battery and Kidnapping.

Although this suspect is under arrest, Riverside Police ask that residents still remain alert and report suspicious activity when noticed.
