### **Pursuit Leads to Officer Involved Shooting**

Riverside, CA. –

On Tuesday, August 30, 2011 at about 1:27 AM, a Riverside police officer in a marked police unit attempted to stop a vehicle in the Casa Blanca area of Riverside. The vehicle failed to stop for the officer who had activated his overhead lights and siren. The pursuit lasted for a couple of minutes and ended with the passenger fleeing on foot in the area of Bunker and Diamond. The officer gave chase on foot and an officer involved shooting occurred. The suspect was taken into custody at a nearby residence. The suspect vehicle and driver fled the scene after the passenger exited and is still at large.

Detectives from the Robbery/Homicide Unit and technicians from the Forensic Unit of the Centralized Investigations Bureau responded and are currently investigating this incident. No one was injured as a result of the shooting. The investigation revealed that the suspect, a parolee, was in violation of his parole and had an outstanding warrant issued for his arrest by the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation.

Daniel Moya, 23, of Riverside, was arrested for 3056 P.C. – Violation of Parole, 11550 H&S – Under the Influence of a Dangerous Drug and 148 PC – Resisting Arrest. He was booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center in Riverside. The investigation is continuing.
