Chop Shop Located

Riverside, CA – On Thursday May 26, 2016, at about 10am, Detective Senon Saldana, an auto theft detective for the western portion of the city, served a search warrant in the 6500 block of Norwood Avenue in the City of Riverside. Members of the Riverside County Auto Theft Task Force known as "RAID" (Riverside Auto-Theft Interdiction Detail) assisted and together they located a "Chop Shop" at the residence. They recovered two stolen vehicles and numerous stolen vehicle parts including car stereos, speakers, stereo amplifiers, engine and transmission, car doors, car seats, numerous car tires and rims, exterior fenders, windshield and car windows. A victim responded to the scene and was able to identify several stolen car parts which had been stripped from his stolen vehicle. The detectives also located several miscellaneous caliber handgun rounds throughout the residence and property which was stolen during a vehicle burglary in the County of San Bernardino. 37-year-old David Carl Goad was already in custody due to an unrelated case. Detective Saldana re-booked Mr. Goad today, May 27th, on new charges including California Vehicle Code 10801 (Operating a Chop Shop).
