Each poem should fit on a single side of an **8.5"x11" (standard size) piece of paper**, in a standard size font like Times New Roman 12 pt.

Poems written by a minor must be submitted by a parent or guardian.



DEADLINE | April 15, 2023

Two poems will be selected from each of three age categories:

- Under 12
- 13-17
- 18+

Selected poets must be available to attend the fair in person and read their poem on stage on Earth Day, April 22, 2023.

Additionally, select poems may be published on the website or in a related publication.
