

STATE OF HOMELESSNESS LOCALLY

- 2019 Point-In-Time Count Summary
 - Sheltered = 34
 - Unsheltered = 94
 - Total Counted = 128 (4.9% of SB County)
- Key Demographics
 - 34.2% first became homeless in last year
 - 40.8% unsheltered chronically homeless
 - 13.8% homeless 2+ years in Ontario
 - 73.7% Male
 - 73.7% White; 47.4% Hispanic
 - 27.6% Age 25-39; 19.7% Age 55-61
 - 57.9% No monthly income




WHAT IS WORKING?

- Strong partnership between City and homeless providers
 - 2005 CoC implementation
- Enhanced Services - LMIHAF
 - Additional street outreach (40 hours/week)
 - Extreme weather motel voucher program
 - Utility assistance program for TBRA
- Innovative Partnerships
 - OMSD TBRA partner
 - Local homeless provider network
 - Ontario Police Department



WHAT ARE THE CHALLENGES?

- Identification of units with private landlords for TBRA
- Lack of affordable housing options
- Acceptance of housing services



WHAT CAN THE REGION OFFER YOU?

- Collaboration
 - Fair share
- Regional approach
 - Large counties and region, difficult to serve population
