CURRENT SITUATION

(Recent updates are posted at the top of Current Situation)

The City of Riverside Fire Department is currently working a 2 alarm vegetation fire in the Santa Ana River bottom, near Market Street. Riverside City Battalion 1 arrived on scene and reported a 1 acre vegetation fire of heavy brush and grass with a rapid rate of spread. Battalion 1 became the Market Street Incident Commander and immediately requested a 2nd alarm brush response to the scene due to the rapid rate of spread on the fire. Riverside City Firefighters made an aggressive attack on the flanks of the fire and were able to stop the forward progress of the fire, and bring it under control in approximately 40 minutes. It has been determined that the fire is in the County of Riverside, and Cal Fire is transitioning onto the incident and will complete mop-up operations on the fire. The fire was held to approximately 2 acres. There have been no civilian or firefighter injuries. The cause of the fire is undetermined at this time pending investigation by Cal Fire
