## **RIVERSIDE POLICE DEPARTMENT NOW RECRUITING FOR CITIZEN'S ACADEMY**

RIVERSIDE, CA – The Riverside Police Department is now accepting applications for the Fall 2019 session of our Citizen's Academy, which begins September 12, 2019, and continues through November 21, 2019. Recruitment will remain open through August 31<sup>st</sup>, or until the class is full.

This course is designed to give our community members an overview of the department's operational methods, and will provide insight as to how police personnel perform their duties. Most sessions will be held in the Riverside Police Department's Community Room, located at 10540 Magnolia Avenue, Suite B, on Thursday evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Class size is limited and applications will only be accepted through the RPD website at [www.riversideca.gov/rpd/community/academy.asp](http://www.riversideca.gov/rpd/community/academy.asp). Applicants must be 18 years or older, and live or attend school in the city of Riverside. Those applying must also pass an informal background check. All sessions are in a classroom setting and may require someone to be able to lift up to 15 pounds and stand for up to three hours.
